## **President's Report**

### 2014 In Review

- ✓ Annual Clean Sweep/Green Sweep Dumpsters were coordinated and all 10 dumpsters were full at the time of removal.
- Drought resistant plants were transplanted along Mountain, University, Opal, 113th and Tambor
- ✓ Granite replenishment was completed along Mountain Rd. and University
- ✓ The Annual Community GAIN Event was held in November and was a wonderful success. City of Mesa District Representative David Luna, and Mesa Police and Fire were in attendance answering questions and providing demonstration of their equipment. Several very nice gift basket door prizes were raffled away to attendees. Many thanks to Maggie, Sophie and Tuesday for their assistance in making this event successful.
- ✓ Old and faded "No Trespassing" signs around the community were replaced
- ✓ Picnic Table Bench had to be replaced at a cost of \$300.00 due to vandalism
- ✓ Concerns were voiced from residents regarding.
  - o people walking their dogs and not picking up after them. Please be considerate and clean up after your pets in order to reduce the spread of illnesses such as PARVO.
  - o multiple newspapers in driveways. Not only does it make the home appear "unoccupied" and higher risk for break-in, but it makes the neighborhood look trashy. Additionally, when they get washed down into the gutter due to rain, it clogs the drainage system.
  - Weeds / yards looking unkept

### <u>Financials</u>

- > 2014 ended with a HOA Dues Delinquency Rate of **6.47%**, the lowest in over 8 years! Great job neighbors!
- 2015 Budget was passed with NO increase in HOA dues for the 6th consecutive year
- ➤ 11 homes were sold in the community during 2014
- > Total Operating Income was \$20,983 over what was budgeted
- ➤ Total Cost of Maintenance & Repairs came in at \$3,152.00 under budget
- Total Actual Administrative Costs were 1,193.70 under what was budgeted

## **Financial Report**

In addition to the financial information included in the year-end President's report, it was noted that the total liabilities & capital for the association was at \$218,600.90. The financial viability of the association remains strong.

### **Election of Directors**

There was one candidate on the Absentee Ballot and another homeowner (John Holt) was nominated from the floor as an additional position on the Board. The candidates Nancy Salzwedel and John Holt were unanimously elected by acclamation.

## **Homeowner Open Forum**

- A homeowner mentioned he would like to see more plants in the common area to replace the missing Agave.
- A homeowner suggested a pesticide through Bug and Weed Mart for the grubs that are killing the Agaves in the common areas.
- Discussion was held regarding grass and debris in and around the culvert in the retention area at Opal and University that is preventing water from draining properly into the retention area. Nakeia will contact the landscaper to clear this area
- Nakeia to contact Code Compliance about the house on Camino with the non-compliance yard.
- Nakeia to check on the covered truck on Camino and Palm tree on Opal.

There being no further business brought forth for discussion, the meeting was adjourned at 7:24 pm.
